Dear Parents and Learners,

I hope that you are all well.

Further to my letter regarding the full re-opening of Schools on the 8th of March, I am writing to keep you updated with regards to our plans for welcoming all learners and staff back to school.

Attached to this letter are the key questions and answers that you may have about our return. We have prepared this document to provide you with some reassurance and reminders about the things we have in place to ensure the safety of your children, your family and our staff, as we prepare for the full re-opening of Lomeshaye Junior School.

Our systems and procedures have been further refined so that all expectations are clear to learners, parents and staff.
